



**Applications are open from the 17th November 2017 to apply for 2020 Forum:**

Burn Survivors and family members. All applicants must be over 18. There is no restriction on applying more than once.

Applications close on February 29<sup>th</sup> 2020. All applications received will be discussed by the Trustees & Board members, whereas a decision will be made on the successful representatives.

All applicants will be notified in writing of their successful/unsuccessful application. This letter will outline the costs covered and provided by the Burn Support Group. Please be sure your passport is up to date for travel and all required information is received at the office within 2 weeks of notification.

The chosen representatives will leave Auckland as a group on the day of the Forum. If you require extra time whilst overseas, this can be taken at the end of Forum, and must be discussed at the time of flight bookings.

Within six weeks of your return, you are required to submit a written report of your experience attending the Forum. This may be published on the BSG website. Please take into consideration you will be acting as a N.Z representative on behalf of the Burn Support Group, this involves commitment and expectations. Consider this prior to your application....
